But in my heart, I lock them all inside.

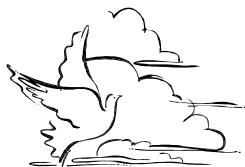

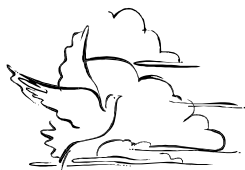

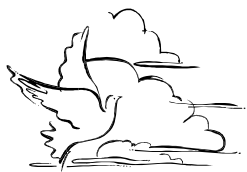
All You have made shows us just who You are

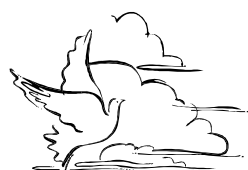
Answer to your prayer, suddenly you're not alone!

It's in your arms I want to stay

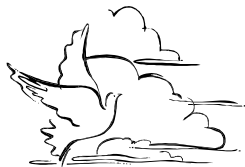
Sometimes – we grow weary, in the shadows of this world at hand

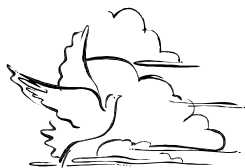
And I know you must be wondering, why I came to you

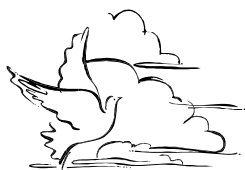

From the peace and joy I never knew before.

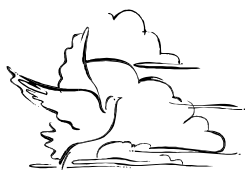
