No need to run, look up and know He's there.

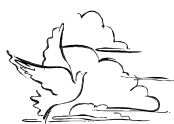

Turn to things above. And He will send His love.

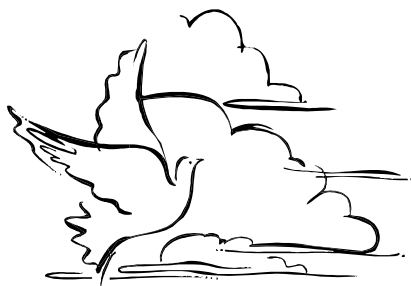

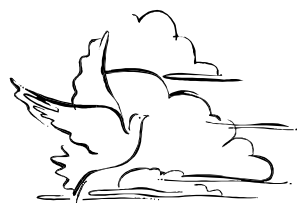
Woe to this world we know
